

To facilitate the issuance of your land access sticker, please adhere to the following requirements:

# 1. Completion of Online ATV Safety Course:

 If not already done, complete the online ATV safety course accessible via the top banner of our website (<u>https://miatvc.ca</u>). When prompted for your location, select Washington as the state. Upon completion, kindly provide the club with a PDF copy of your certificate for inclusion in your membership profile.

## 2. ATV/ORV Documentation:

- Ensure your ATV/ORV is covered by basic ICBC liability insurance (\$100,000) for loading, unloading, and crossing public roads. This insurance must be renewed annually.
- Obtain third-party private land liability insurance for \$1,000,000.00 through Got Toys or a comparable insurance broker.

## 3. Tow/Transport Vehicle Documentation:

• Secure \$2,000,000 public liability insurance for your tow/transport vehicle.

### 4. Liability Waivers:

• Familiarize yourself with and sign the liability waivers outlined in the land access agreement available on our website.

## 5. Additional Requirements for NI1000 Riding:

- If you anticipate riding the NI1000 at any point during the year:
  - Increase your ATV/ORV's ICBC public liability insurance to \$2,000,000.
  - Provide the club with a copy of your driver's license.

## 6. Document Submission:

• Email all required documents to miatvc.membership@miatvc.ca in PDF format. Each document should be a separate file named according to the format: [Your Name] - [Document Name] - [Year].pdf (e.g., John Doe - ATV 3rd Party Liability - 2024.pdf).

Upon receipt and processing of the necessary documents, the club will promptly dispatch your membership sticker. Should you require any further assistance or clarification, please do not hesitate to reach out.
